The following decisions were taken in the meeting:

- 1. The National Building Construction Company (NBCC) and the Educational Consultants India Ltd. (ECIL) gave their presentation to the Executive Committee. While the NBCC stated that they would charge 11.5% of the cost estimate as fees, the ECIL stated that they would charge 11%. It was decided that further action in this rejord may be studied by CSD, RGNIYD & Registrar alongwith DS(YS).
- 2. The composition of the Advisory Board as mentioned in the Memorandum of Association was again scrutinised by the Executive Committee and the following were decided:
 - There is no need to have any representation from the Departments of Women and Child Development, Rural Development, Health and Family Welfare, Information and Broadcasting, Environment, Labour and Welfare. Instead of this, the Advisory Board may consist of eminent person from the field of Environment, Science and Technology, Health an Family Welfare, Rural Development and Vocational Training. A panel of names will be put up to select the suitable persons in each category.
 - (b) Secretary, University Grants Commission and the representative from the Central Social Welfare Board may also be deleted from the Advisory Board.
 - (c) Bharat Scouts and Guides may be represented by their Director instead of National Commissioner.
