

Backdrop

Social science is the field of study concerned with society and human behaviors. Social science is commonly used as an umbrella term to refer to a plurality of fields outside of the natural sciences. The resource situation of social science research is varied. Whenever, a research is conducted in any subject/area of social sciences, a number of questions arise like: Are there sincere and dedicated researchers with the necessary education and professional experience to conduct research? Are they able to identify research themes that are relevant to society, and to develop research questions? Do they have the necessary skills to develop research proposals? Can they conduct research alone or lead research teams efficiently? Whether research results to improve the system? Whether the research study leads to improve the earlier policies?

Since a number of research institutes, universities and colleges as well as independent researchers and NGOs are involved in research at various levels, there is a pressing need to train the young researchers who can complete research in time. The young researchers also need to be encouraged to take up research at various levels, which will contribute to policy making and decision-making in various organizations concerned with inclusive development. This workshop is designed to provide clarification in Research Methodological procedures and Designs for the scholars pursuing research with respect to qualitative and quantitative methods along-with training in Statistical package useful for Social Science disciplines.

About the Workshop

This Research Methodology Workshop is expected to provide the advanced theoretical and practical knowledge by exposure and use of different statistical package to research students of four stages - Master Degree students (preparing for writing brief dissertation work), planned to pursue the doctoral research programme, those who are at the stage of their data analysis and field work; and final stage of their thesis writing. It will cover the basics of research methodology focusing on theoretical and practical inputs. Specifically, the formulation of research problem, formulation of research hypothesis and testing of hypothesis, conducting literature review, data collection methods, selection of appropriate parametric or non-parametric statistical method for analyzing data, and report writing.

Objectives

- The inputs would be about developing a theoretical and methodological framework of their research, conceptualization and framing research questions, etc.
- To provide input to students who are in the planning stage of their doctoral research.
- To provide input to the student who are currently in the middle of fieldwork/data collection.
- To provide input to students who have finished field work and are in the process of writing.
- To enable the scholar to plan and conduct field surveys and related procedural experience in both qualitative & quantitative methods.
- To create understanding and conduct research in social sciences.
- To provide skill for data processing and management in excel, statistical packages.
- To provide information for quantitative data analysis: SPSS, STATA,R etc. Qualitative data analysis : NVivo, MAXQDA, ATLAS.ti etc.
- To provide clarity with respect to statistical and interpretation techniques of statistical output.
- To provide skill in preparing research reports.
